Final Mission Review.
Final Staff Electronic and Team Briefings.
Final Public Briefings if Required.
Final Interagency Coordination Planning.
Issue Staff and Volunteer Standby Orders.

CERTCON Level 1

Emergency Operations

1. Execute the IAP.
2. Incident Briefing and Issue IAP to all Staff Members.
3. Evaluate Operations during Incident Commander Briefings.
4. Adjust IAP after each Operational Period (12 Hours).
5. Repeat Steps 1 to 4 for Duration of Event.
6. Hot Wash
7. End Deployment and Release from Incident.
